# **School Annual Education Report (AER)**

January 31, 2025

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-2024 educational progress for the Prairie Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2023-2024 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

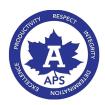
Prairie Elementary School has NOT been given one of these labels.

#### **Process for Assigning Pupils to the School**

Prairie Elementary School, as part of the Adrian Public School System, participates in a school-of-choice cooperative agreement with other schools in the county following Sections 105 and 105c of the State School Aid Act. School of Choice applications are handled through the board office and are handled individually based upon available spots at every grade level.

The same process was used for the 2022-2023 school year.

The Status of the 3-5 Year School Improvement Plan



Prairie Elementary School's Improvement Plan aligns with the district's Strategic Plan that includes literacy, with both reading and writing, and math. This process is continually evaluated and revised to meet current student needs.

Professional development continued to be a priority as we invested in the instructional model "Gradual Release of Responsibility." Teachers have been advancing their skills in this model, which remains a cornerstone of the Adrian Instructional Model, our primary instructional framework. We have also emphasized more engaging, hands-on learning and increased the use of classroom discussions.

Through the school improvement process, we identified a critical area of focus, which we have begun to work on this year: foundation skills and phonics. We believe addressing these priorities will enhance our instructional practices and lead to greater student achievement. We will provide professional development for all K-5 teachers on the latest phonics instruction methodologies, focusing on systematic and explicit teaching of phonemic awareness, decoding, and word recognition.

- Integrate phonics instruction across all content areas to reinforce phonetic skills in context.
- Implement daily small-group interventions for students who are struggling with phonics to ensure targeted support.
- Monitor student progress through regular formative assessments and adjust instruction accordingly to meet the needs of all learners.
- Encourage family involvement by providing resources and strategies to support phonics

#### 2022-2023 School Improvement

We continue to use the Multi tier system of support (MTSS) to help us deliver reading instruction. Tier 1 is what teachers provide to all students, this includes guided reading and ability grouping for a portion of reading instruction. Tier 2 includes an additional layer of support from the classroom teacher 4-5 times a week for 15-20 minutes each session and it may also include support from a Reading Specialist. Tier 3 is a third layer of support that includes the classroom teacher providing tier 1 and 2 and the Reading Specialists providing the third tier level support. The third tier layer of support comes from the Reading Specialist 4 to 5 times a week for 20-30 minutes for each session.

## **2023-2024 Specialized Schools Annual Report**

The students of Adrian Public Schools receive special education services through the Lenawee Intermediate School District (LISD). In addition to the specialized schools, students receive diagnostic testing, school psychology, school social work, physical and occupational therapy, career technical education, special needs training, and speech pathology services.

The Lenawee Intermediate School District provides educational services to students from birth through age 26 who have severe handicaps. Students with severe physical, mental, emotional, or sensory impairments may receive their educational program in a classroom



operated by the LISD. Less than 10 students students from Adrian Public Schools attended LISD classroom programs during the 2023-24 school year.

The LISD operates the Laura Haviland Program for early elementary, elementary, middle, and high school students with severe emotional and behavioral impairments. Twenty students from Adrian Public Schools attended Laura Haviland during the 2023-24 school year.

In cooperation with the Lenawee County Probate Court, the LISD operates the juvenile education program housed at the Maurice Spear Campus.

LISD operates special education classrooms in local districts including classrooms for students with physical or other health impairments and hearing impairments in Madison; and classrooms for students with cognitive impairments in Tecumseh and Adrian. Twenty students from Adrian Public Schools attended these programs during the 2023-24 school year.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. Less than 10 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2023-24 school year.

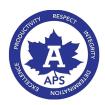
The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors. 199 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2023-24. This equals 51.3% of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2024 study of 2023 graduates) showed 58% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 76.6% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 94.7% were working (full-time or part-time) with 3.3% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 61.3% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. Less than 10 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2022-23 school year.

The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors.151 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2022-23. This equals 43% of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2023 study of 2022 graduates) showed 56.6% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 76.7% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 91.4% were working (full-time or part-time) with 5.0% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 75.4% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.
