For the 2023-2024 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Process for Assigning Pupils to the School

Springbrook Middle School consists of students in grades sixth through eight. Students living in District in grades sixth through eight attend Springbrook Middle School Adrian Public Schools participates in a school of choice cooperative agreement with other schools in the county in accordance with Sections 105 and 105c of the State School Aid Act. School of Choice applications are handled through the board office and are handled individually based upon available spots at every grade level.

This same process was used in the prior 2022-2023 school year.

School Improvement 2023-2024

At Springbrook Middle School, our mission is to foster a dynamic, relevant, and rigorous curriculum that fosters a safe, inclusive, and innovative learning environment that will equip every student with the academic, social, and emotional skills needed to excel at Springbrook Middle School and in their lives after. We will incorporate different district strategies such as Portrait of a Graduate, the Diploma Plus Program, and Attendance Challenges to empower students to become lifelong learners, critical thinkers, and compassionate citizens in a diverse and rapidly changing society.

2022-2023

Implementation of the attendance challenge mentor program will be implemented. Working lunches and after school opportunities for students will be created for students to complete school work

Specialized Schools Annual Report

2023-24 Specialized Schools Annual Report

The students of Adrian Public Schools receive special education services through the Lenawee Intermediate School District (LISD). In addition to the specialized schools, students receive diagnostic testing, school psychology, school social work, physical and occupational therapy, career technical education, special needs training, and speech pathology services.

The Lenawee Intermediate School District provides educational services to students from birth through age 26 who have severe handicaps. Students with severe physical, mental, emotional, or sensory impairments may receive their educational program in a classroom operated by the LISD. Less than 10 students from Adrian Public Schools attended LISD classroom programs during the 2023-24 school year.

The LISD operates the Laura Haviland Program for early elementary, elementary, middle, and high school students with severe emotional and behavioral impairments. Twenty students from Adrian Public Schools attended Laura Haviland during the 2023-24 school year.

In cooperation with the Lenawee County Probate Court, the LISD operates the juvenile education program housed at the Maurice Spear Campus.

LISD operates special education classrooms in local districts including classrooms for students with physical or other health impairments and hearing impairments in Madison; and classrooms for students with cognitive impairments in Tecumseh and Adrian. Twenty students from Adrian Public Schools attended these programs during the 2023-24 school year.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. Less than 10 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2023-24 school year.

The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors. 199 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2023-24. This equals 51.3% of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2024 study of 2023 graduates) showed 58% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 76.6% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 94.7% were working (full-time or part-time) with 3.3% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 61.3% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.

The LISD PREP Academy provides educational programs for teen parents from Lenawee County. During the student's instructional program, childcare support is provided. Less than 10 students from Adrian

Public Schools attended the LISD PREP Academy during the 2022-23 school year.

The LISD TECH Center offers career technical education programs for high school juniors and seniors.151 students from Adrian Public Schools attended the LISD TECH Center or participated in the co-op/work experience program during 2022-23. This equals 43% of the junior and senior population for this school district.

The most recent follow-up of LISD TECH Center students (a 2023 study of 2022 graduates) showed 56.6% were continuing their education. Of those continuing their education, 76.7% were continuing in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program. In addition, 91.4% were working (full-time or part-time) with 5.0% reporting they were unemployed/seeking employment. Of those working full-time, 75.4% were in a field related to their LISD TECH Center program.
